

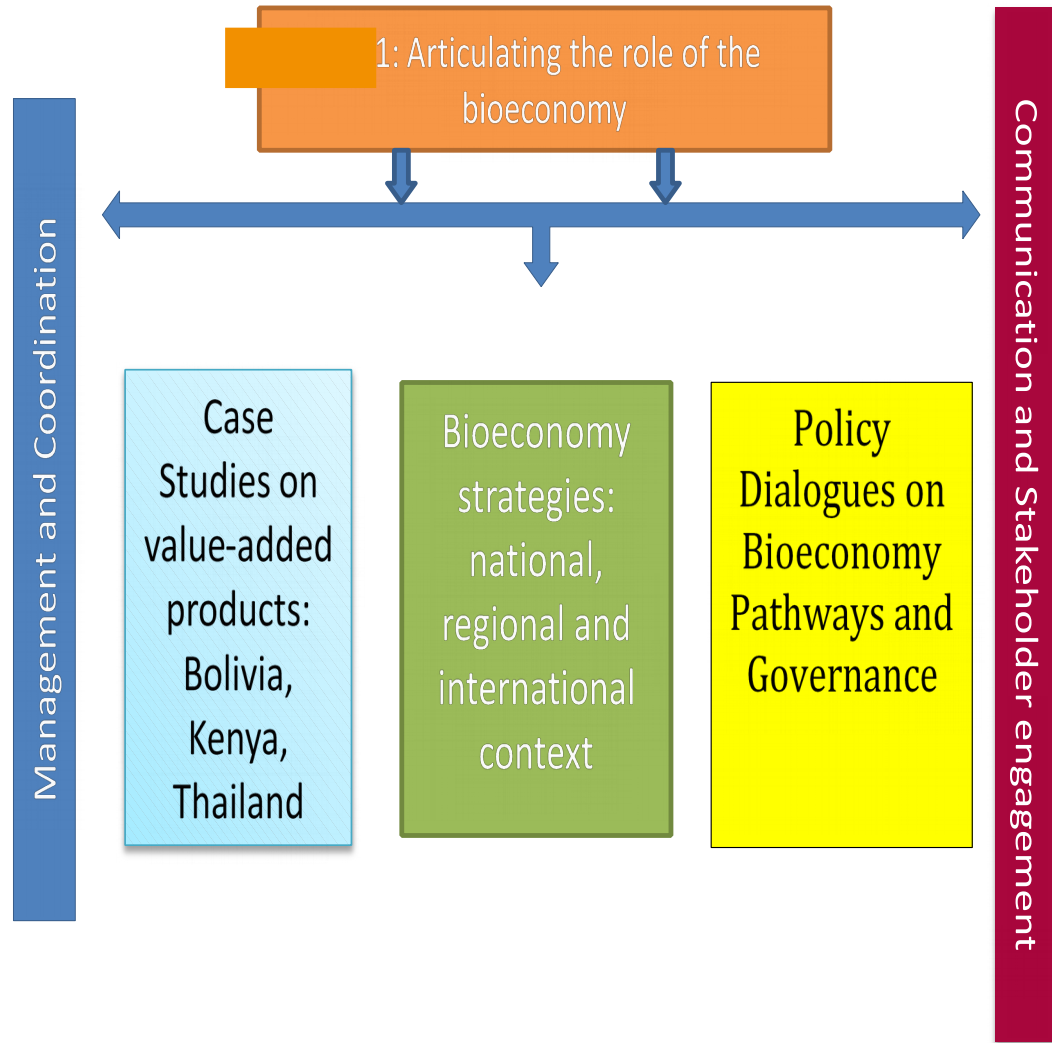

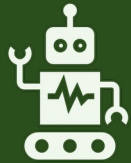

Bio- resource vision

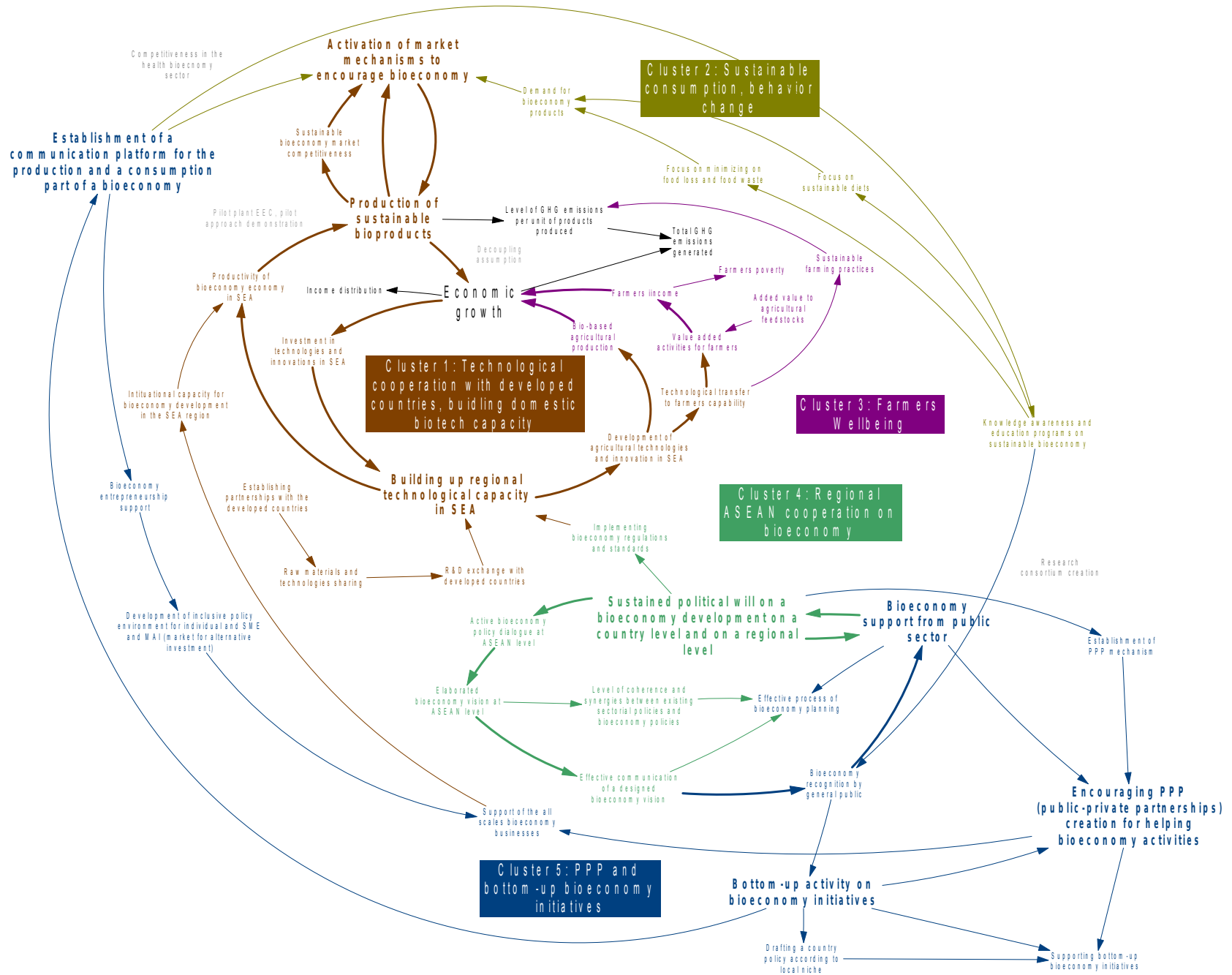
Achieve economic growth and sustainability through conversion and upgrading of bio-resources for human use



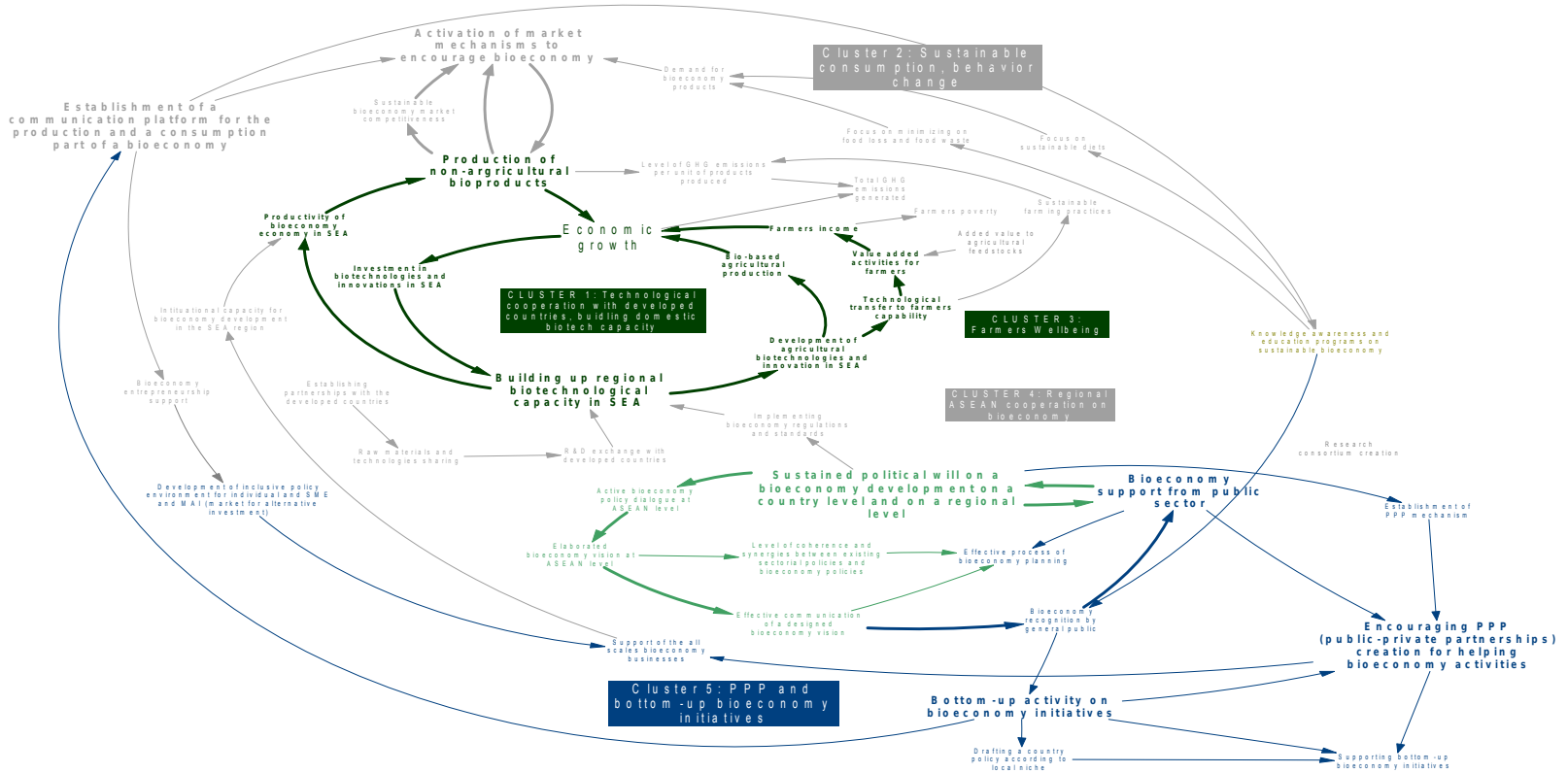
Bio-ecology vision
