- Integrating **strategic foresight** into policymaking

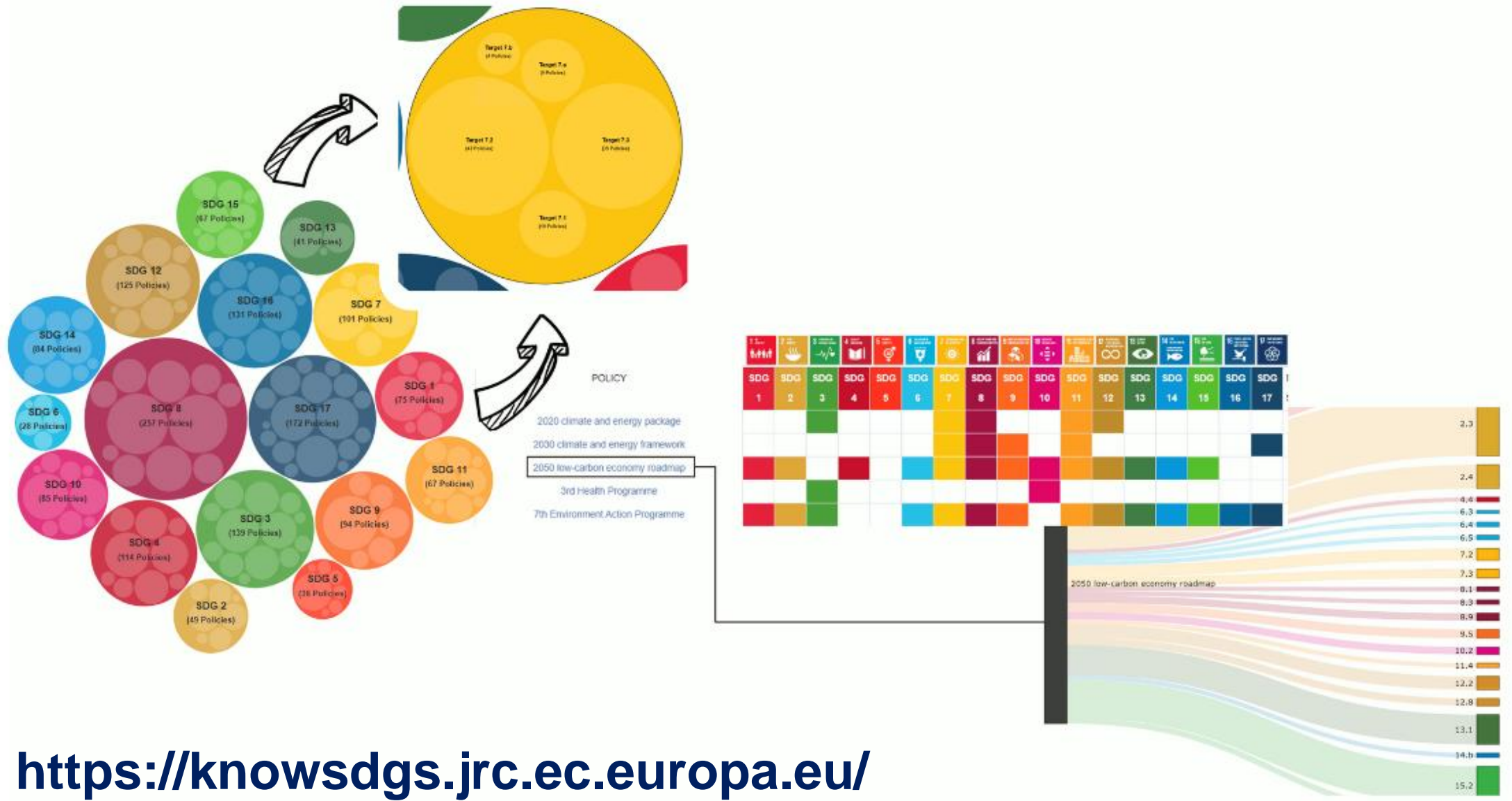

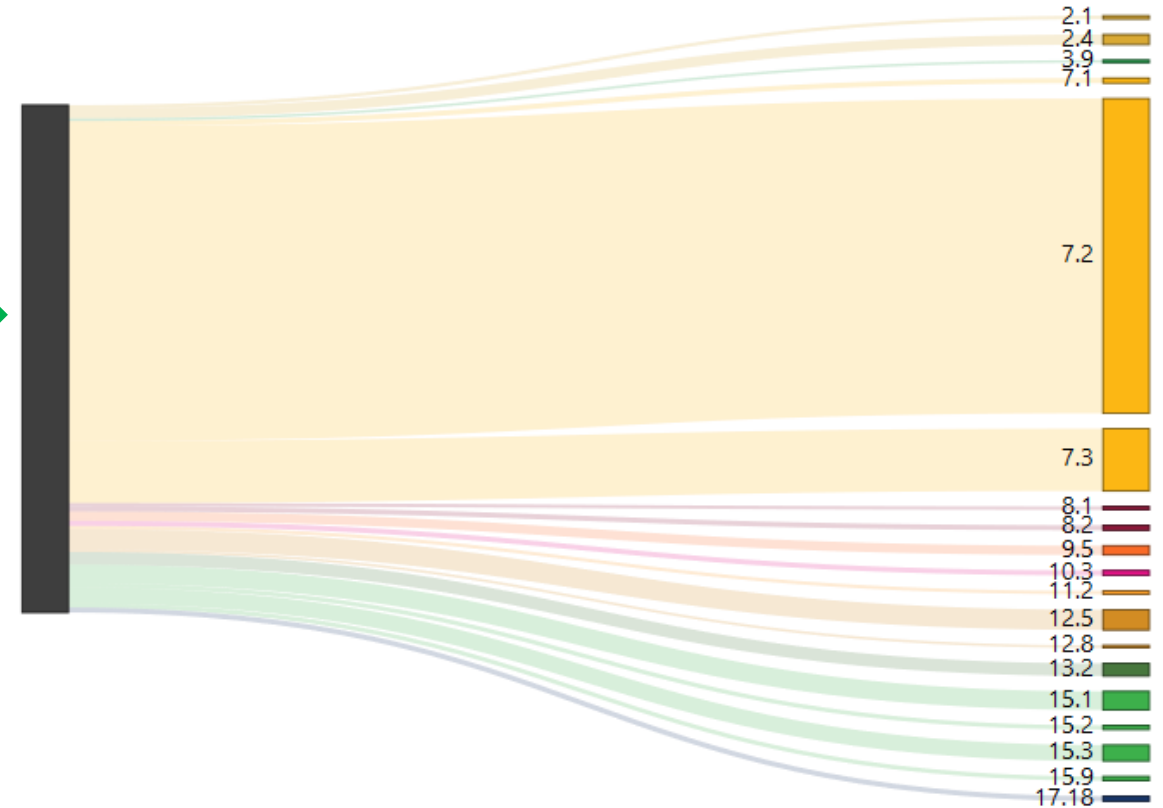
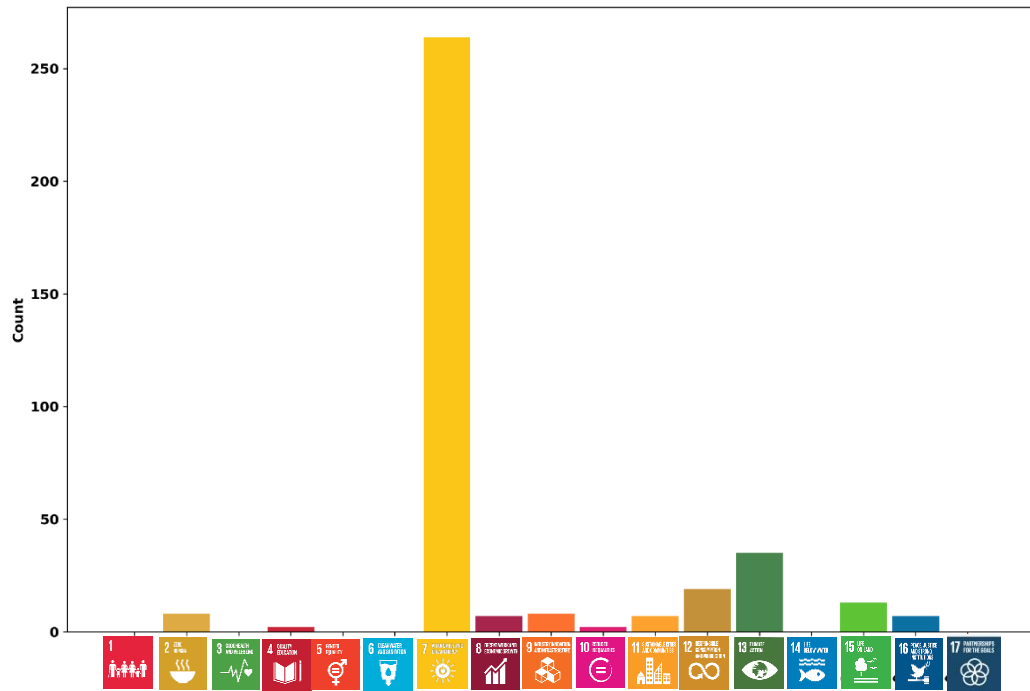
- ✓ transparently

- ✓ considering all different steps of the policy cycle.



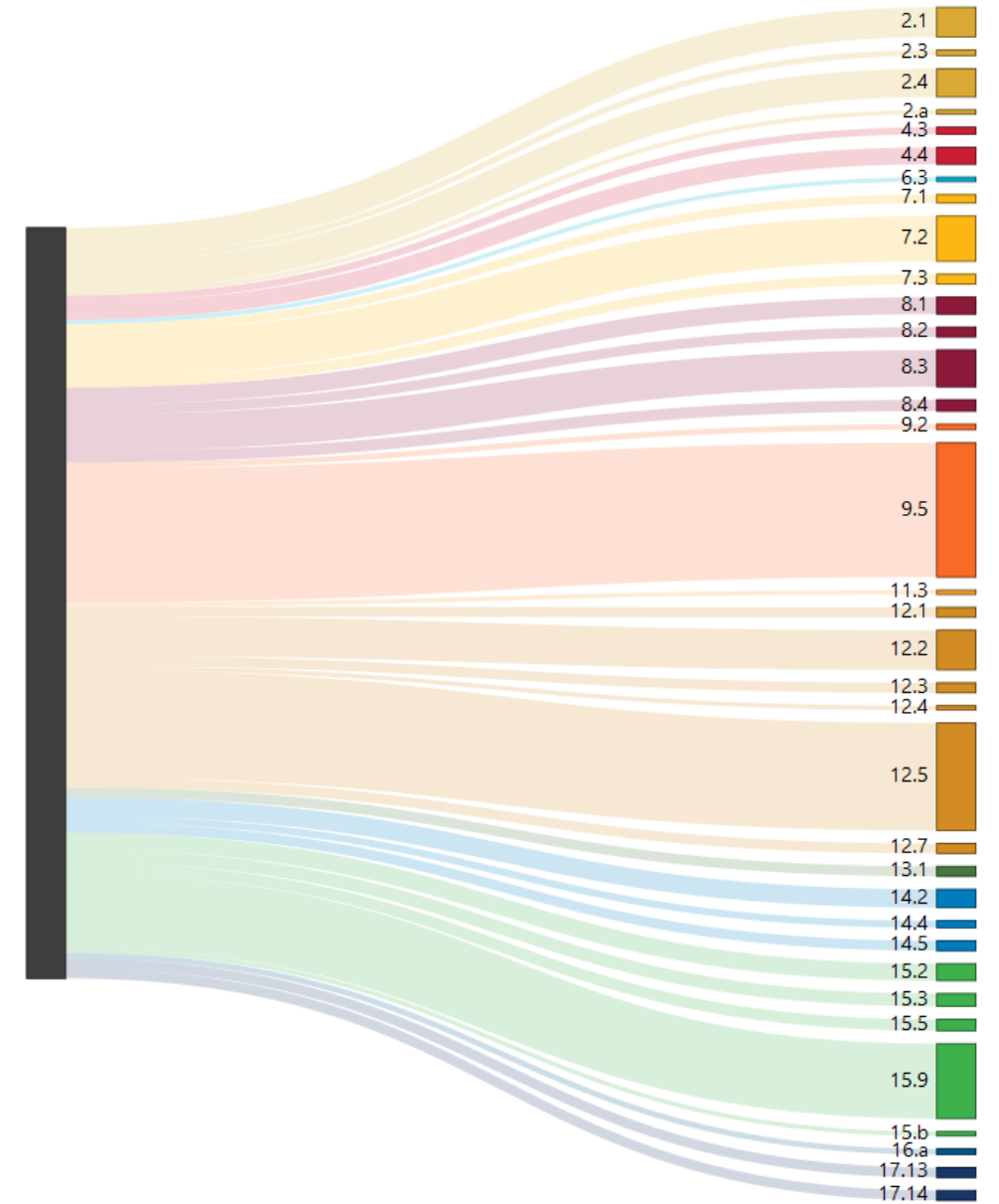
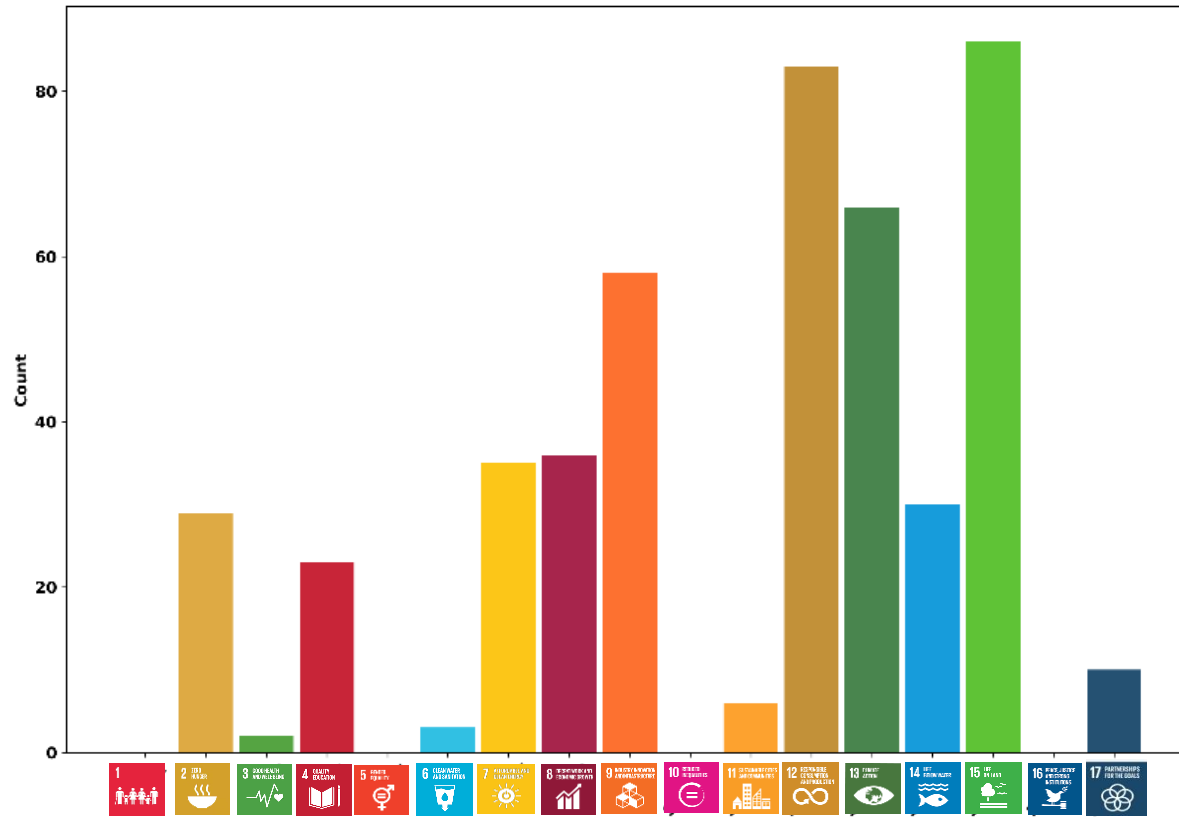
Mapping EU policies to SDGs



Examples: the RED II

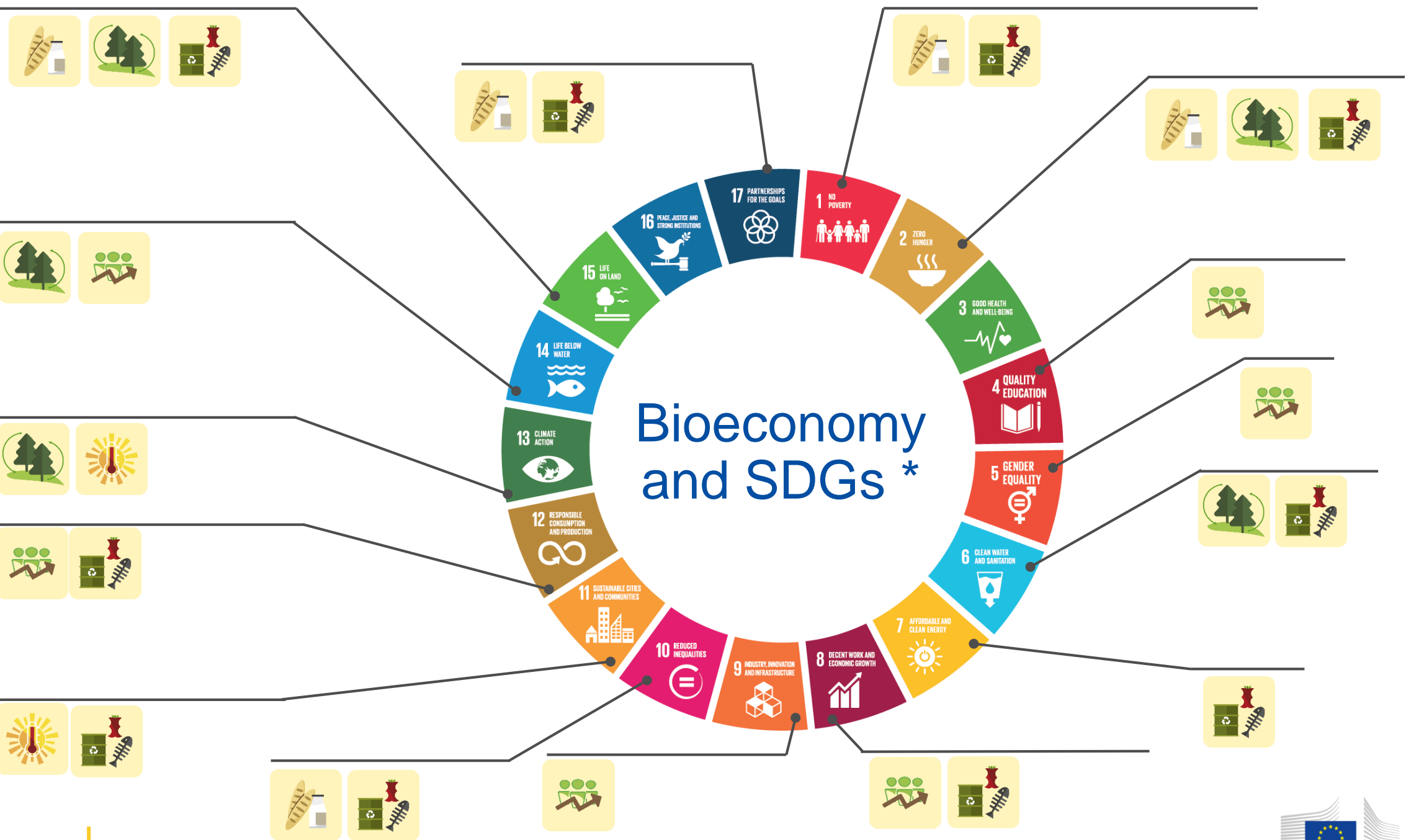


Examples: the Bioeconomy Strategy

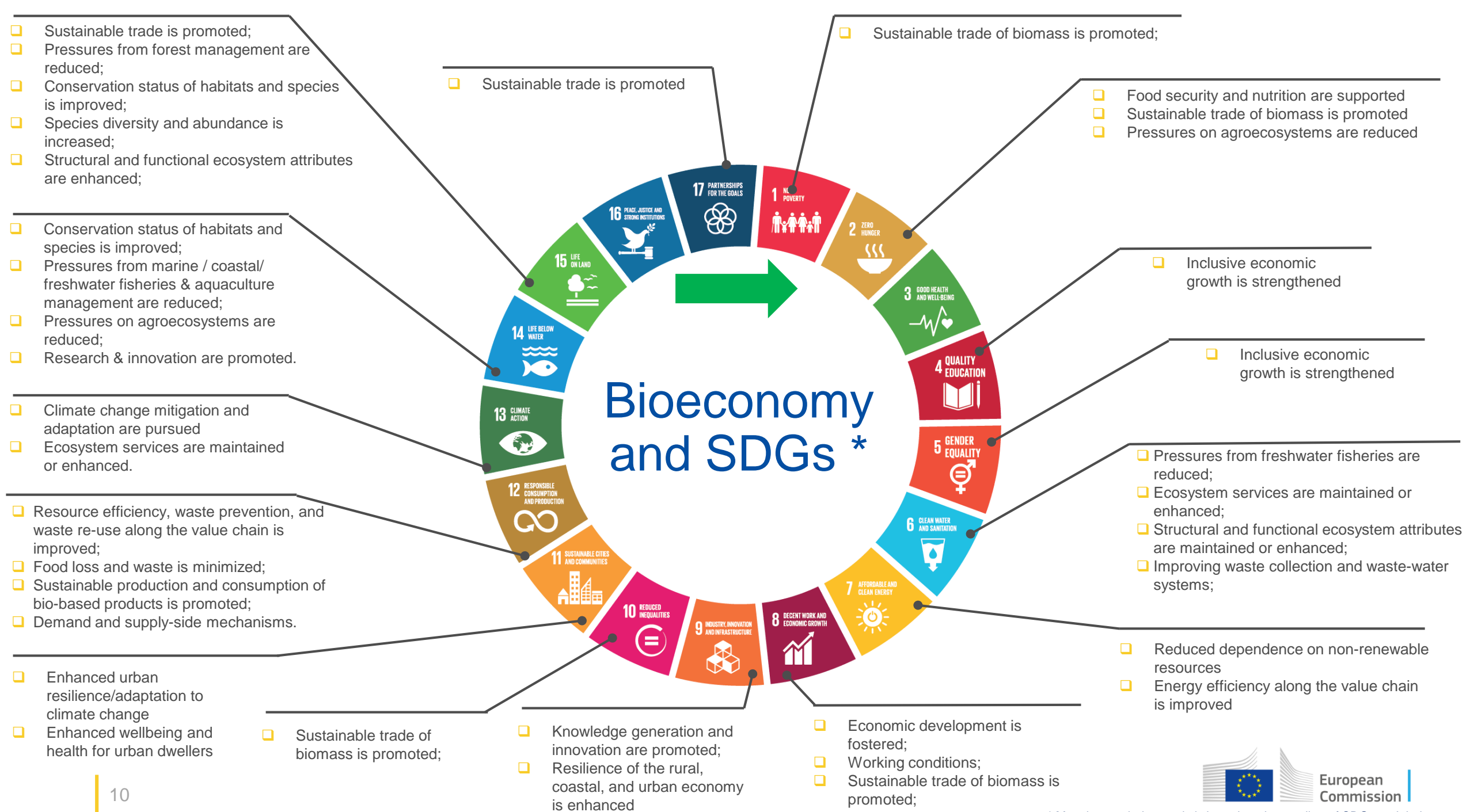


The 5 Objectives of the EU bioeconomy
